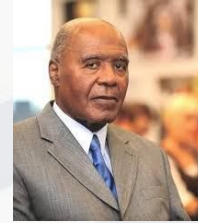

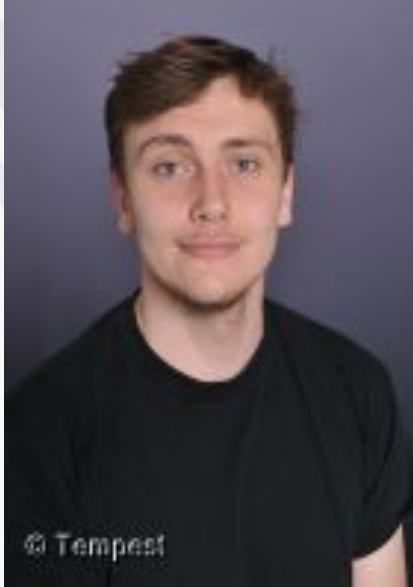

The Mr. Brown Spirit of Sport Award

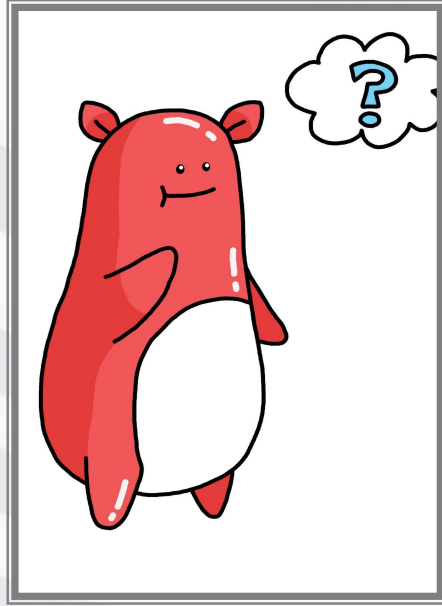
